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## PUPPY POTTY TRAINING TIPS

Potty training can be both the easiest and hardest thing you'll do with your puppy.

The steps are simple but hard because you NEED to be on top of it without fail.

Being consistent and on top of your puppy potty training is critical.

Here are some tips I recommend:

- Make a potty schedule on a white board and have it in a high traffic area of the house (the kitchen for example). Put the date at the top, then below the times and whether puppy went #1, #2, or both. Take a picture after each day to look back on to recognize your puppy's patterns/routines.
- Take your puppy outside OFTEN. And I mean OFTEN.
- Go out WITH your puppy to ensure they go.
- Use a command ("go pee/poo") and throw them a party after they go as praise! (not while they are going because it will distract them).
- When not directly supervised, your puppy should be kept safely in an ex-pen or kennel and should not have freedom in your house, even if you are home.
- Your pup is most likely to potty after eating, drinking, playing, or waking up.
- Do NOT scold puppy for accidents in the home. If they had an accident inside, it's because you haven't been on top of taking them out often enough. Take that as your accident and learn from it.
